



Important Information



- Location: 80 M Street, SE, Washington, DC (5th Floor)
 - Building hours are 7am to 7pm
 - Building access outside
 of these hours can be
 arranged by contacting
 your Engility Point of Contact
- Contact Information:

 - Fax (202) 203-3001
- Parking:
 - Hourly pay parking is available in the building from 7 am to 7 pm M-F
 Costs Early Bird (Before 9 AM) \$11 / day; Otherwise \$16.00 / day
 - Nearby parking lots are available for \$3-20 daily
 - Street Parking is not recommended, however there are limited metered parking spaces
 - If there is a Nationals game, the rate will increase to \$25.00; all day
- Metro (Subway): Washington Navy Yard Station on the Green Line. The Half Street entrance to the station is across the street from our office.

Metrorail Fares

Peak fares are in effect:

- Weekdays from opening to 9:30 a.m. and between 3:00 and 7:00 p.m.
- From midnight until closing on Friday and Saturday nights.

Off-peak fares are in effect at all other times. For more information, see the Metrorail Fares page.


To determine the fares between two stations, go to the Metrorail Stations page and click on the station where you're starting your trip.



Metrobus Fares

Metrobus fare for regular routes is \$1.60 using a SmarTrip® card or \$1.80 using cash. The fare for express routes is \$3.65 using a SmarTrip® card or \$4 using cash. Fare for seniors and people with disabilities is 80¢ for regular routes, \$1.80 on express routes.

You must have exact change. Bus operators do not carry money. Please have your pass, transfer or exact fare ready when you board. For more information, see our Metrobus Fares page.

- Please alert the Engility POC or Security at check-in if classified material is brought into the building or if overnight storage is required.
- Visitor Badge:
 - A government issued photo ID is required for check-in
 - Visitor badges will be issued and should be returned to the Receptionist desk at the end of your visit.
 - Escorts are required in all Engility office areas

Security: Classified Visits



- Classified Visits:
 - If you are here for a classified visit, before you enter the facility you must:
 - Contact Engility FSO to make sure your visit request has been received.
 The information is on the preceding slide.
 - Foreign Visitors must contact their embassy and follow the instructions provided by them. The embassy will then contact our customer to sponsor them for a site visit. Our sponsor will forward the visit request to us. This process takes awhile so it must be submitted 30 days before the date of the visit.
 - If Foreign Visitors are in this facility for unclassified visits, the same rules apply.
- Any adherence to these procedures will stop entry into this facility.

Security: Classified Documents/Media/SIPRNET



- Classified Document(s)/Media:
 - If you are hand carrying classified:
 - You must contact your Engility POC to let them know that you have it.
 - Make sure it has the appropriate markings, downgrading instructions, double wrapped, coversheets and provide 2 copies of the transmittal receipt that goes along with the document. We sign both copies and give one back to you. If this is a "roundtrip" visit (meaning you are not leaving the document with us), then the transmittal receipt must say "roundtrip".
 - If you do not meet any of these requirements, your document(s)/media will not be received and will be returned.
- Rules for SIPRNET
 - Contact your POC(s) (by phone or email) 24 hours before classified meeting starts to verify documentation has been received.
 - Make sure it has the appropriate markings and downgrading instructions pertaining to the NISPOM.
 - If the document does not have required appropriate markings and downgrading, it will not be received.


- Badges Issued at the Receptionist desk
